Summer 2024 Season  
**MANAGER'S RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. It is the manager's responsibility to know all of the rules and to make sure that all his/her players follow them. The rulebook is available for download off the RAS website [www.ramonaadultsoftball.org](http://www.ramonaadultsoftball.org) or is available by request by email. Requests may be made to [adultsoftball.ramona@gmail.com](mailto:adultsoftball.ramona@gmail.com)
2. Player's first and last names must be printed clearly on the roster and scorecards and the name must be their legal name. NO NICKNAMES
3. **ROSTERS AND SCORECARD – IF NAMES ON THE SCORECARDS DO NOT MATCH THE ROSTER; THEN THE PLAYER LISTED ON SCORECARDS WILL NOT GET GAME CREDIT TOWARDS PLAYOFFS.**
4. **Rosters and Scorecard violations: First violation the Team Manager will get 1 warning and second violation and subsequently the team will get an automatic forfeit each time the violation occurs per season.**
5. The Team Manager must make sure that **ALL** players have signed a team roster. If during a game/tournament a team is found playing with an illegal player that game is an immediate forfeit.
6. **NO DRUGS/INTOXICATED PERSONS** - RAS currently has a **NO HARD ALCOHOL OR BEER or MARIJUANA** policy in effect. RAS also has a **NO DRUG or PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION** policy in effect as of May 2010. We ask that the Managers and Tournament Directors help to enforce both of these rules, and keep all players and fans affiliated with their teams in control at all times. This is a family friendly park. We need to keep it that way.
7. **MINIMUM PLAYERS/TEAM** A team consists of a minimum of 8 legal ROSTERED players (a person who has signed a roster) made up of 5 men and 3 women.
8. **\*PICKUP player** is a player rostered to another team for the same night. \*You may pick up 2 additional players, to field a 9-man team. If you do not have at least seven (7) of your rostered players within 50 feet of your dugout at game time, then you will forfeit the game and pay all fees. COED: Must always have a minimum of 3 girls.
9. If you know before your scheduled game that you are going to forfeit, you must call the Player Representative as soon as possible. In order to avoid the forfeit fee, a call must be made prior to 1:00 pm on the day of game.
10. NO kids under the age of 18 in the dugout - Children under the age of 18 are not allowed in the dug-out. Failure to comply will result in a possible forfeit.
11. Managers, please remind your players to clean up the trash in the dugouts after their games and help the league keep a clean environment for everyone.
12. Team must be ready to play at games times -6:30 game only has a grace period, and this means only if you are short players this allowed, not for players walking in or being out in the parking lot. Have your team there before game times so we are not delayed on game time starts
13. USA complaint bats only allowed – There are some USA Bats that are banned and are not allowed to be used while playing in the RAS league. [www.afcsl.org/approved-bat-list](http://www.afcsl.org/approved-bat-list)
